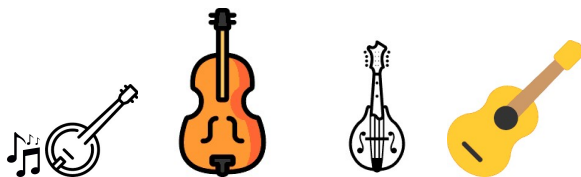
1. Chesley MacDougall Award
